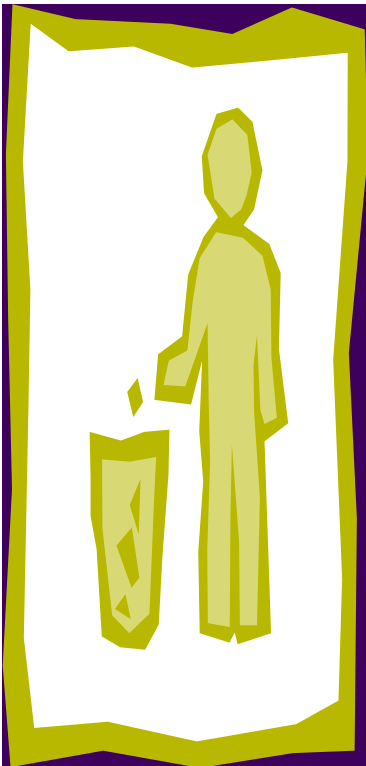

HOW TO KEEP YOUR ESTATE TIDY

- Place all rubbish in a bin or, if it can be recycled, a recycling facility.
- If it is safe to do so, you can pick up other peoples litter and put it in the bin.
- Make sure your household waste is properly contained whilst awaiting collection so that it does not spill or blow around the streets.
- Remove any litter from your own premises as this can easily migrate to a neighbours garden.
- Do not drop rubbish in the street. Always make sure you put any litter in a bin.
- Ensure chewing gum is disposed of properly in a bin.
- Dispose of your cigarette ends safely in a bin.
- Litter dropped on the street does not miraculously disappear. If left, a drinks can would take hundreds of years to degrade.
